




We were fascinated by this limestone wall right on our first meeting.

The Struve Arc was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List ten years ago as a common heritage uniting ten countries.






The Struve Arc is the segment measured from the Arctic Ocean to the Black Sea to confirm the shape and size of the Earth.







In order to measure the Struve arc, the triangulation method was used.




The Võivere point was considered destroyed, but in 2001 it was found thanks to GPS measurements.



In 2011 the Võivere point was marked with glass pyramid.
